

#### GENERAL BUSINESS

- 2024 racing calendar survey results
  - o 21 members responded
  - o Almost half of those said they would get an MA licence in 2024
  - Majority of voters wanted the season to start in March and end in November
  - Majority wanted 6 or 7 rounds in 2024
  - o 9 voters said they didn't want any rounds at lakeside
  - o Most voters wanted 1 or 2 rounds at Morgan Park
  - If you would like to see the full results of the survey please contact Doug
  - Once we can get a 2024 calendar off QR,MP and lakeside we will use this data to figure out our 2024 series the best we can.
- MA price increase
  - MA have increased their licence fee by 15% which ends up being \$550. They say this is due to insurance costs.
- QSC logbook scrutineer notes
  - o There is concern that log book scrutineering notes are not being followed up on
  - Currently the DSO stamps the log book as a competition record.
  - We will create a file that has any scrutineer notes against the kart/drivers name. The DSO will
    be given this file so that they can check whether the issue has been fixed up or not when the
    stamp the log book.
- Practice days, non-race weekend
  - o QR have offered practice days for us on the same day as they hold burnout events.
    - This would require us using a configuration of QR that doesn't use turn 1 or 2
    - This would still be a way of getting on track to test and tune





























- The cost of this would be much reduced
- o The practice sessions at QR this year that are before their sprint events are run under MA.
- Lakeside have test and tune sessions available but karts are on track with other open wheelers. The club advises against this due to safety concerns.
  - Members can participate in these events if they choose to at their own risk.
- The skid pan at the front gate at QR is also available to hire if we ever want to set up a come and try type of thing for new people.
- o The Dyno at Coach design is available too, contact Chryss or Russ Jamieson to set up a time.
- Ampol local club grant
  - o The club is going to see whether we can apply for this.
